
Grammy Nominated Artist Travis Scott To Perform During NBA Awards on TNT, Monday, June 25, at 9 p.m. ET

Turner and the **NBA** today announced that Grammy nominated artist **Travis Scott** will perform at the **NBA Awards on TNT**, presented by Kia, to be held **Monday, June 25**, with coverage beginning at **9 p.m. ET**. Scott will perform his hits “Butterfly Effect” and “Goosebumps” for the packed house, honoring this year’s biggest and best moments from the 2018 NBA season. Hosted by Anthony Anderson, the night is sure to be a must-see event.

The **2018 NBA Awards on TNT** – presented live from historic **Barker Hangar in Los Angeles** – will honor all of the league’s top performers from the 2017-18 NBA season, including the exclusive unveiling of the Kia NBA MVP, Kia NBA Defensive Player of the Year, Kia NBA Rookie of the Year and Lifetime Achievement Award, among others.
